Learn the basics of tying flies with avid fly fisherman, Mr. Mike. All practice materials are provided. Class size is limited for each session. **Pre-registration is required.** This program is recommended for those 8 years of age and older. Sessions are 2 hours.

**WINTER BIRD WALK & GREAT BACKYARD BIRD COUNT: FEBRUARY 18 @ 10 A.M.** The Audubon Society of Kalamazoo will lead this winter bird walk where participants will discover the many birds that stay in Michigan throughout the winter season. The program is part of the *Great Backyard Bird Count* and will last approximately 90 minutes. The open habitat on the ponds can be exceptionally cold and windy. Please dress appropriately for the weather. All ages welcome.

**HATCHERY TOURS: FEBRUARY 18 @ 10 A.M., 12 P.M. & 2 P.M.** Discover how the DNR raises millions of fish every year to stock in Michigan's lakes, rivers and streams! Tours are approximately 30 minutes. All ages welcome.
