Choose any 3 activities

Choose a bird and list 5 adaptations it has that make it successful in its habitat.

Write or tell a story from the viewpoint of a bird.

Draw a map of your yard or street using a "bird's eye view" (as if you are flying overhead).

Watch birds outdoors or at your window for at least 10 minutes. Record what they were doing.

Listen to some bird songs outdoors or online. Make up your own song about birds.

Build a nest using materials from nature.

Choose your favorite bird from your yard or a book and write a poem or haiku about it.

Draw a picture of an imaginary bird using any colors you like. Draw the bird's habitat, too.
