1. This form is for the use of State of Michigan permitted Falconers. It must be completed for each transfer, acquisition, release, loss, or re-banding of a migratory bird held under the permit. You must submit it to the Michigan Department of Natural Resources Wildlife Division Permit Specialist within 5 days of activity. This form may be emailed, faxed or mailed in.

<u>If you have:</u>	<u>Then you must complete sections:</u>
Transferred a bird to another permittee (or to another permit you hold)	1,2,3 and 6
Released a bird or lost a bird due to its escape, theft, or death	1,2, and 6
Acquired a bird from another permittee, other than a rehabilitator	1,2,3 and 6
Captured a bird from the wild or recaptured a previously captive (banded) bird	1,2,4 and 6
Re-banded a bird, either wild or captive-bred, for which the band was lost or removed	1,2,5 and 6

2. Retain one copy of the completed form and mail one copy to the Department of Natural Wildlife Division Permit Specialist. The Permit Specialist will update the US Fish and Wildlife Service Federal Database.
