


Michigan Turkey Harvest (1965–2013)



In Michigan, we have been very successful in working with partners to restore wild turkey populations. We have been actively engaged with local Chambers of Commerce and partners such as the National Wild Turkey Federation. In 2013, Michigan ranked 7th in the nation for turkey harvest and we rated as having some of the highest quality turkey hunting in the country. The entire state is open to spring turkey hunting and we have one of the longest seasons on the continent with license buyers from all 50 states and international license buyers from Canada, Italy, Finland, Mexico, Germany and Puerto Rico.
