

Muskellunge and Tiger Muskellunge Fishing Regulations (April 1, 2013 through March 31, 2014)

Waterbody	Fishing and Harvest Season	Minimum Size Limit	Possession Limit
Upper Peninsula Great Lakes and inland waters, and St. Marys River	May 15 - Mar. 15	42"	1 per year per angler in a given license year
Lower Peninsula inland waters	Last Saturday in Apr. - Mar. 15	42"	
Lower Peninsula Great Lakes	Open all year	42"	Note: A Muskellunge Harvest Tag is required to harvest a muskellunge (see note below)
Lake St. Clair, St. Clair River, and Detroit River	First Saturday in Jun. - Dec. 15	42"	
All Michigan - Wisconsin boundary waters, except Menominee River	May 15 - Nov. 30	40"	
Menominee River (from Hattie Str. Dam to the end of the breakwalls in Green Bay)	May 15 - Nov. 30	50"	
Thornapple Lake, Barry County	Last Saturday in Apr. - Nov. 30	50"	

Muskellunge Harvest Tag information: A non-transferable muskellunge harvest tag is required to harvest muskellunge. The muskellunge harvest tag is free and is available at all fishing license vendors wherever licenses are sold. Anglers who do not possess the Muskellunge Harvest Tag will have to release all muskellunge caught.
