Payments

Step 1: Clear any outstanding tickets on your driving record. You will need to contact the court in the jurisdiction where you received the ticket to make payment arrangements.

Step 2: Pay your Driver Responsibility Fee. Payments **must** be made to the Michigan Department of Treasury—not the local Secretary of State. Please allow **14 days** for payment processing. Please call 1.800.950.6227 for payment options. Note: The Secretary of State cannot track your payment.

Step 3: If your Driver Responsibility Fee is not cleared before your suspension date, your license will be suspended indefinitely, or until the Driver Responsibility Fee is paid in full. Once suspended, after payment is made to the Department of Treasury, you will need to return to the Secretary of State branch office to pay a \$125 reinstatement fee.

Suspensions

If you have received a Driver Responsibility Fee suspension notice, your license will be suspended indefinitely, or until the Driver Responsibility Fee has been paid in full.

During the indefinite Driver Responsibility suspension period:

- A restricted license cannot be issued.
- There is no hardship appeal on the fee amount or suspension.
- The DR suspension will not be lifted even if payment arrangements are made. The suspension is lifted only after full payment is made.
