Connecting Michigan Communities 2.0 Grant Comment and Objection Form

Submission Deadline: All grant comments and objections are due by 4:00 PM EST on May 5, 2021.

Submission Guidelines: Completed Comment and Objection Form(s) and supporting documentation must be received by the Department of Technology, Management, and Budget (DTMB), Center for Shared Solutions by 4:00 PM EST on May 5, 2021, to be considered. Anyone interested in submitting a comment or objection is required to email their completed form and all attachments to DTMB-CMICGrant@michigan.gov. Submitters will receive an email confirmation in receipt of their submission. It is the Submitters' responsibility to ensure their submission is received by DTMB prior to the submission deadline. Submissions sent to the wrong email address or received after the deadline will be rejected. Official submission date and time will be determined by the time stamp accompanying the email. Submissions dated and time stamped in any other way will be rejected. If a confirmation receipt is not received within two business days, Submitters must contact the CMIC Grant Program Office at (517) 335-3727.
