The State of Michigan is seeking proposals from parties interested in purchasing the Michigan Department of Corrections' former "Camp Manistique" property located at 401 North Maple Street in Manistique, Michigan; consisting of a 39,323 SF main building, a 1,800 SF garage/shop building and a few misc. other out-buildings all sited on a 30.297 acre parcel.

The Michigan Department of Technology, Management and Budget (DTMB) determined that initial bid period did not produce a proposal that sufficiently meets all of the State's needs. In accordance with Section VII of RFP No. 2009-0146, the State is therefore extending the bidding period until it receives a viable bid that DTMB deems to better reflect the market value of the subject property and the other interests of the State as expressed in the original RFP solicitation. The first qualifying bid that is received and accepted will end the extension period.
