SUBJECT: Report on the Drinking Water Laboratory Testing Fund

The Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Laboratory Services Section, provides analytical testing of drinking water to Michigan's citizens, communities, and water supplies for the protection of public health and compliance with Michigan's Safe Drinking Water Act, 1976 PA 399, as amended.

In accordance with Section 9601(4)(a)-(c) of the Public Health Code, 1978 PA 368, as amended, following is EGLE's report on the Drinking Water Laboratory Testing Fund for fiscal year 2019:

Number of Laboratory Tests Performed	124,032
Total Fees Collected/Revenue	\$2,092,929
Total Cost for Tests/Operational Expenditures	\$2,395,866

At the end of fiscal year 2019, the Laboratory had a \$2,137,827 forwarding balance.
