ATTENTION CONSUMERS

The State of Michigan enacted, Part 169, Scrap Tires, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Part 169) to prevent the illegal disposal of scrap tires.

If a consumer requests to keep possession of the tires being replaced, the retailer is required to obtain the signature of the consumer on an invoice, receipt or other record acknowledging retention of those tires.

The consumer may refuse to sign; however, the retailer shall make a note on the invoice, receipt or other record indicating that the consumer refused to sign; acknowledging the retention of ownership of those tires by the consumer.

Please note: The law does not limit the ability of the retailer to obtain additional information from the consumer if the consumer retains the tires replaced.

IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO DISPOSE, DISCARD, BURN, OR OTHERWISE RELEASE SCRAP TIRES TO THE ENVIRONMENT IN A MANNER CONTRADICTORY TO THE STATE OF MICHIGAN SOLID WASTE REGULATIONS.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES PART 169 IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT OR FINES.
