Legislative Report

No Further Action Reports Approved by Operation of Law

Report Period: Fiscal Year 2019

This report is provided in accordance with Section 20112a(6) of Part 201, Environmental Remediation, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

Section 20112a(6) of Part 201 requires the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) to determine the percentage of no further action reports approved by operation of law under Section 20114d of Part 201 and to notify the standing committees of the Senate and House of Representatives with jurisdiction over issues related to natural resources and the environment if the percentage exceeds 10%.

A no further action report is a report under Section 20114d detailing the completion of remedial actions at a facility. EGLE received 38 no further action reports in fiscal year 2019, and 4 of those were approved by operation of law, representing 11% of the total received.
