# Legislative Report

## Report on Permitting and Licensing

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

One of the ways the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE) achieves its mission of protecting Michigan’s environment and public health by managing air, water, land, and energy resources is by assuring permits and licenses are issued in accordance with environmental standards. Permit issuance is one of EGLE’s core functions for projects ranging from homeowner permits for seawall installations to large manufacturing air permits.

EGLE administers 62 different permits and licenses, including 28 authorized under the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (NREPA). Section 1311 of Part 13, Permits, of the NREPA, requires EGLE to report information on individual permitting and licensing programs annually.

In fiscal year (FY) 2020, 27,194 applications were received for EGLE’s 62 permit and license categories. Nearly 97 percent of the permit/license actions were approved. Below is a complete summary of FY 2020 actions. Additional details regarding EGLE’s various permits and licenses are attached.

\*The number of applications approved, withdrawn, and denied differs from the number of applications received in a fiscal year as some applications are received in one fiscal year and approved, withdrawn, or denied in another fiscal year. Denial of a permit/license occurs when the applicant does not meet the regulations or due to lack of information provided to process the application.

### Percentage of Applications Received by Division in FY 2020

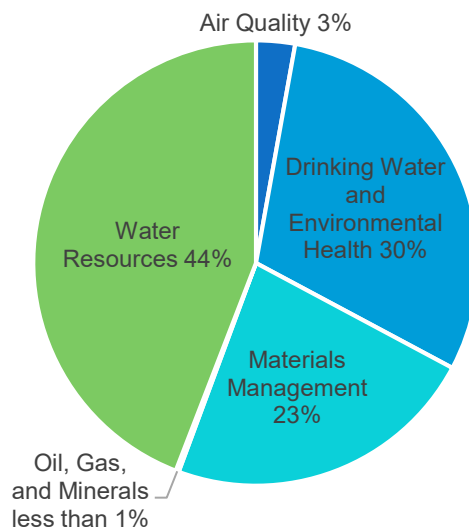
EGLE has five divisions that issue permits and licenses.

- The Water Resources Division is responsible for keeping Michigan’s water resources clean and safe. Over the last year, the division has seen a record number of permit applications due to high-water levels and resulting erosion. Permits are issued to individual homeowners for things like seawall installation and other protective infrastructure. The division is responsible for ensuring homeowners’ actions do not negatively impact the environment and/or their neighbors.
- The Drinking Water and Environmental Health Division issues permits for new construction of drinking water systems, as well as administering the state’s pools and campground programs.
- The Materials Management Division issues permits related to the proper disposal of waste.
- The Air Quality Division and Oil, Gas, and Minerals Division assure industrial practices are done safely and legally and maintain overall environmental quality and protection of public health.

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*The Water Resources Division experienced a nearly 20% increase in permit applications received compared to the prior year.*
