

# Farm Tap Appliance Rebate Program



## Potential Risks of Using a Farm Tap:

- Not detecting a gas leak and/or being susceptible to fire or explosion
- Gas pressure fluctuations
- Using unprocessed gas
- Liability for damages or injuries

**The Good News:** The Michigan Agency for Energy has a Farm Tap Appliance Rebate Program to help you with the costs of switching to another fuel source like non-farm tap natural gas, electricity, propane or wood pellets.

If you take action and switch to another fuel source, you may qualify for up to \$1,500 from the Michigan Agency for Energy to assist you with the cost of switching to newer, safer and more efficient appliances.

## To be eligible you must:

1. Be the homeowner with a farm tap gas connection
2. Permanently terminate your services with your farm tap gas provider
3. Establish an active account for natural gas with your local utility, or a propane or wood pellet provider

## If you qualify, you could receive up to a \$1,500 rebate for purchasing new appliances including:

- Oven ranges
- Hot water heaters
- Furnaces
- Dryers
- Smart energy devices
