# APPROVAL OF SUBMISSION OF ASSESSMENT REPORT AND ACADEMIC AND FINANCIAL OPERATING PLAN

WHEREAS, on October 30, 2019, the Michigan Department of Treasury (the "Department"), the Michigan Department of Education ("MDE"), and Benton Harbor Area Schools (the "District") executed a Memorandum of Understanding (the "Memorandum") to achieve the objectives set out in that Memorandum; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Advisory Committee as follows:

- 1. That the completed assessment report and academic and financial operating plan be submitted to the State Treasurer, MDE, and the School Board.
- 2. That the minutes of the Advisory Committee meeting at which this Resolution is adopted take notice of the adoption of this Resolution.
- 3. This Resolution shall have immediate effect.
