

**Summary of Michigan Department of Environmental Quality Actions  
In Response to the  
United States Environmental Protection Agency Emergency Administrative Order  
Updated: 2/12/2018**

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Emergency Administrative Order contains 15 overall items to be addressed by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ). This update includes status only on items for which progress was made in the last week. It is anticipated that the next update to this summary will be provided on Tuesday, February 20, 2018, due to President's Day on Monday, February 19, 2018.

**DETAILED INFORMATION:**

Paragraph 54:

- On 2/9/2018, the MDEQ published an amendment to the environmental assessment for additional hydrovac work. This document will be posted on the website on or shortly after 2/12/2018.

Other:

- As of 2/12/2018, the MDEQ was working to report online the first two weeks of school sampling of Flint Community Schools conducted as part of round 1. Week 3 samples were being analyzed, which would complete round 1.
- Round 2 Flint Community Schools sampling was delayed the weekend of 2/10/2018 due to weather.
- Round 2 Flint Community Schools sampling weeks 1 and 2 will be done 2/17/2018.
