EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Emergency Administrative Order contains 15 overall items to be addressed by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ). This update includes status only on items for which progress was made in the last week. It is anticipated that the next update to this summary will be provided on Monday, May 7, 2018.

DETAILED INFORMATION:

Paragraph 54: Service line removal

- The city of Flint issued a press release on 4/26/2018, announcing that hydrovaccing began. Per the press release, approximately 6,000 homes will be hydrovacced this year as part of Phase V of the FAST Start pipe replacement program.
- The press release also stated that three contractors are currently out replacing lines under Phase IV.
- The request for bids closed 4/26/18 for Phase V pipe replacement work.
