

**Summary of Michigan Department of Environmental Quality Actions  
In Response to the  
United States Environmental Protection Agency Emergency Administrative Order  
Updated: 10/16/2017**

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The United State Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Emergency Administrative Order contains 15 overall items to be addressed by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ). This update includes status only on items for which progress was made in the last week. It is anticipated that the next update to this summary will be provided on Monday, October 23, 2017.

**DETAILED INFORMATION:**

**Paragraph 54: Inventory of homes with lead service lines.**

- As of 10/16/2017, the City of Flint has replaced 4,838 service lines and identified 987 copper-to-copper lines.

**Paragraph 53: All lead in water testing results.**

- The MDEQ began implementing round 6 CLEAR sampling, with bottle drop-off on 10/16/2017 and pick-up starting 10/19/2017.
