**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Emergency Administrative Order contains 15 overall items to be addressed by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ). This update includes status only on items for which progress was made in the last week. It is anticipated that the next update to this summary will be provided on Monday, November 5, 2018.

Paragraphs 57 – 62: Chlorine residuals; corrosion inhibitors; corrosion control; technical, managerial and financial capacity; necessary, capable and qualified personnel; water quality optimization plan including better documentation and enhancing communications.

- On 10/25/2018, the city of Flint sent a letter to the MDEQ in response to the MDEQ's 10/22/2018 Order under the Safe Drinking Water Act. This letter was posted online on 10/26/2018.
