

**Summary of Michigan Department of Environmental Quality Actions
In Response to the
United States Environmental Protection Agency Emergency Administrative Order
Updated: 12/4/2017**

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The United State Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Emergency Administrative Order contains 15 overall items to be addressed by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ). This update includes status only on items for which progress was made in the last week. It is anticipated that the next update to this summary will be provided on Monday, December 11, 2017.

DETAILED INFORMATION:

Paragraph 54: Inventory of homes with lead service lines.

- As of 12/04/2017, the city of Flint had replaced 6,024 service lines and identified 1,266 copper-to-copper lines.

Paragraph 61: Necessary and capable staff.

- AECOM was approved by City Council as the project management contractor, pending approval by the Receivership Transition Advisory Board (RTAB) on 12/13/17.

Paragraph 63: Independent advisory panel.

- A Flint Water Interagency Coordinating Committee (FWICC) meeting was held on 12/01/2017.
