

**Summary of
Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy
Actions in Response to the
United States Environmental Protection Agency
Emergency Administrative Order
Updated: 4/20/2021**

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Emergency Administrative Order contains 15 overall items to be addressed by the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE). This update includes status only on items for which progress was made in the last week. It is anticipated that the next update to this summary will be provided on Tuesday, April 27, 2021.

Paragraph 53B

- The city of Flint (City) continues to make progress with their sampling efforts for this current monitoring period, January 1 - June 30, 2021. The City is working diligently to identify sites and collect samples for compliance. In accordance with the Concerned Pastors Settlement Agreement, the City will collect samples at a minimum of 30 sites (half of the 60 sites required for compliance) during the months of May and/or June.
