

**Summary of
Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy
Actions in Response to the
United States Environmental Protection Agency
Emergency Administrative Order
Updated: 2/10/2020**

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Emergency Administrative Order contains 15 overall items to be addressed by the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE). This update includes status only on items for which progress was made in the last week. Due to scheduling conflicts next week, it is anticipated that the next update to this summary will be provided on Monday, February 24, 2020.

Paragraph 60 b.ii.C.

- On January 29, 2020, the city of Flint requested an extension for the completion of the construction to the chemical feed building. The new date being proposed was March 31, 2021. On February 3, 2020, the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy granted the extension and will continue to track the progress of the milestone during the status meetings.
