

**Summary of
Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy
Actions in Response to the
United States Environmental Protection Agency
Emergency Administrative Order
Updated: 4/13/2020**

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Emergency Administrative Order contains 15 overall items to be addressed by the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE). This update includes a status only on items for which progress was made in the last week. It is anticipated that the next update to this summary will be provided on Monday, April 20, 2020.

- In light of the response efforts for the COVID-19 emergency, on Monday, April 2, the city of Flint invoked Section XIV. Force Majeure on the service line replacement program, pursuant to the Settlement Agreement in *Concerned Pastors for Social Action, et al. v. Khouri, et al.*
