

**Summary of
Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy
Actions in Response to the
United States Environmental Protection Agency
Emergency Administrative Order
Updated: 9/9/2019**

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Emergency Administrative Order contains 15 overall items to be addressed by the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE). This update includes status only on items for which progress was made in the last week. It is anticipated that the next update to this summary will be provided on Monday, September 16, 2019.

- The city of Flint continues to make progress on identifying the service line material at the addresses sampled during the monitoring period for January 1, 2019 through June 30, 2019, as part of the request in the Violation Notice sent August 16, 2019. Their final updated Lead and Copper Report is due to EGLE on September 16, 2019.
