Actions in Response to the

Emergency Administrative Order
Updated: 9/15/2020**

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Emergency Administrative Order contains 15 overall items to be addressed by the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE). This update includes status only on items for which progress was made in the last week. It is anticipated that the next update to this summary will be provided on Tuesday, September 22, 2020.

Paragraph 53B

- On August 28, 2020, the city of Flint submitted their Lead and Copper Rule Report to EGLE. It is currently under review for calculation of the 90th percentile.
