**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) Emergency Administrative Order contains 15 overall items to be addressed by the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE). This update includes status only on items for which progress was made in the last week. It is anticipated that the next update to this summary will be provided on Tuesday, December 15, 2020.

Paragraph 53B

- On December 7, 2020, EGLE completed their review of the city of Flint's Lead and Copper Rule Report, covering the period of time from July 1 to December 31, 2020, and calculated the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile at 6 parts per billion (ppb) for lead based on the 61 verified Tier 1 and Tier 2 samples that were included for compliance monitoring.
