Below is the City's response to the letter you sent via email on June 14, 2018 regarding the transitioning of lead copper rule sampling back to the City of Flint. We acknowledge receiving the letter and look forward to once again handling the lead copper rule sampling at the City of Flint. The City of Flint will have F&V Operations and myself overseeing the monitoring.

The City of Flint has a concern regarding LCR sampling. The LCR doesn't have provisions for municipalities eliminating its historic tier 1 sampling pool at an accelerated rate such as we are doing in Flint. The EPA, DEQ and COF have been working to come up with a way of dealing with this unique situation and I look forward to the continued collaboration and ultimately the direction from the regulatory agencies on how to move forward.
