The Blavin Scholars Fund was established in 2006 by Paul and Amy Blavin to provide assistance to undergraduate Michigan students who have financial need. The Blavins have a special interest in supporting students who have been a part of the foster care system, orphans, and wards of the court.

Eligibility

- Michigan resident seeking an undergraduate degree.
- Demonstrated financial need.
- Current or previous foster children, orphans, or wards of the court.

How to Apply

- Submit a 2008-2009 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the federal processor at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Be sure to list Federal Code 002325 so that a copy will be sent to the University of Michigan—Ann Arbor. Students are strongly encouraged to submit the FAFSA by March 1 for consideration. Submitting your FAFSA by this date allows processing time for the Office of Financial Aid to receive your FAFSA by the March 15 scholarship deadline.
- Submit a statement of interest in the scholarship along with documentation verifying your status as a current or previous foster child, orphan, or ward of the court.

Deadline

The University of Michigan's Office of Financial Aid must receive your statement of interest documentation and FAFSA record from the federal processor by March 15 to consider you for this scholarship.

Selection

Each year, the University of Michigan's Office of Financial Aid will review the list of eligible applicants and select recipients who best meet the scholarship's eligibility criteria.

Notification

Selection of the recipient will be announced by April 1.

Number/Amount

- A maximum of 8 scholarships will be awarded each year. The scholarship is renewable.
- An average award of \$5,000 will be awarded. The amount of the scholarship varies, depending on the annual income from the endowment fund (\$1,000 minimum).
