The Prosecuting Attorneys Association of Michigan (PAAM) Child Abuse Training Services program, in cooperation with the Prosecuting Attorneys Coordinating Council, and the Department of Human Services (DHS), is pleased to present a statewide cross-professional Specialized Child Abuse Training seminar on the topic of *Drug Endangered Children*. This seminar will be held Tuesday, August 16, 2011. The seminar will begin with registration at 8:00 a.m. and conclude by 4:30 p.m..

Ken Stecker, PAAM's Traffic Safety Resource Prosecutor, will review the "Medical Marihuana Act." This Act permits the possession and use of marihuana to treat or alleviate conditions or symptoms associated with certain debilitating medical conditions. Attendees will learn who is protected by the Act and the activities (possession, cultivation, use, etc.) authorized by the Act. Detective Lieutenant Tony Saucedo, with the Methamphetamine Investigation Team at the Michigan State Police, will discuss the direct and indirect risks of meth exposure to a child.

Enclosed, please find a copy of the registration form for the seminar. There is no tuition charge or charge for materials for this seminar. Attendees are responsible for overnight accommodations, transportation, meals, and other incidental costs.
