REPORT :

The Committee of Claims, to which was referred the petition of John R. Williams, report :

The petitioner was an inhabitant of Detroit on the surrender of that post by General Hull, and was put on board of the cartel British vessel called the Caledonia, for Fort Erie, with his personal property, to the value of \$1,461. The wind, he says, was unfavorable, and prevented him from landing his property ; that he heard an attack would be made on the cartel by the American forces, and, apprehending his goods might be lost, he applied to General Hull, who said they would be safe. He says he tried to save them, but the Caledonia was captured by the American vessel John Adams, and he lost his goods mentioned.

This part of the claim was presented at the first session of the 15th Congress, and a report unfavorable to the merits of it was made on the 13th of March, 1818 ; and it is recorded in vol. 4, page 481, to which the committee refer.

He asks to be remunerated for the loss of store goods, at Buffalo, in December, 1813, to the amount of \$4,500, which, he says, were in the store-
