

REDUCING UNINTENDED PREGNANCIES

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Women's Preventive Service Guidelines

Women have access to a full range of recommended preventive services without cost sharing, including:

- ▶ Well-woman visits
- ▶ Screening for gestational diabetes
- ▶ Human papillomavirus (HPV) DNA testing for women 30 years and older
- ▶ Sexually transmitted infection (STI) counseling
- ▶ Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) screening and counseling
- ▶ FDA-approved contraception methods and contraceptive counseling
- ▶ Breastfeeding support, supplies, and counseling
- ▶ Domestic violence screening and counseling

▶ Teen Pregnancy Prevention Programs

- Taking Pride in Prevention
 - 12 funded programs
 - 9,317 youth and 3,153 parents served (FY 12–13)
- Michigan Abstinence Program
 - 9 funded programs
 - 5,114 youth and 632 parents served (FY 11–13)
- Michigan Adolescent Pregnancy & Parenting Program
 - RFP active – funding available for 5 programs

▶ Child and Adolescent Health Centers

- School-Based & School-Linked Health Centers
 - 2nd largest program in U.S.
 - 77 funded health centers
 - 30,224 unduplicated youth served in FY 12
- School Wellness Program
 - 8 funded programs
- Transformational Healthcare
 - 7 funded programs

▶ Michigan Model for Health

- LEAs – 84%/16% at HS and 60%/40% at MS
- *Abstinence-based(comprehensive)/abstinence-only*
