Secure Transporter Vehicle Storage

Licensed Secure Transporter vehicles are not required to be parked overnight at the primary place of business of the licensee if the vehicle does not contain marijuana products.

Overnight storage of marijuana products can only occur at the licensed facility of the secure transporter. A secure transporter may not maintain custody of marijuana products for more than 48 hours – or by permission of the MRA on a case-by-case basis.

Medical Marijuana Facility Secure Transporter Licensees

A Secure Transporter shall have its primary place of business as a marijuana facility that is operating in a municipality that has adopted an ordinance that meets the requirements of section 205 of the Medical Marijuana Facilities Licensing Act.

Secure Transporters must report the addresses where vehicles are stored via the licensee's staffing plan. The staffing plan must have this information in order to pass inspections, both pre- and post-licensure.

Adult-Use Establishment Secure Transporter Licensees

A secure transporter shall store vehicles at its primary place of business. If a marijuana secure transporter stores a vehicle that does not contain marijuana or marijuana product at a location that is not its primary place of business, it will indicate that in its establishment plan.

Secure Transporters must report the addresses where vehicles are stored via the licensee's establishment plan. The establishment plan must have this information in order to pass inspections, both pre- and post-licensure.
