Thelen provided an overview of MiPlus and discussed what to expect during and after the transition.

Rules Discussion

Ditschman indicated that she is keeping an eye on proposed legislation that may affect the current draft rules. Ditschman stated that the rules are on track for public hearing by next spring.

Allegation Review Committee

Chiaravalli reported that in August, the committee reviewed 56 files of which 43 were authorized for investigation and 13 were closed. There are 5 new files that need to be reviewed.

RDH Committee

Franklin reported that the committee met today, prior to the Board meeting, and discussed the Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) requirement for renewal. The Committee members have received questions on whether an online course is acceptable and stated that licensees have reported that CPR training without a hands-on component is acceptable to LARA. Ditschman indicated that she would research the American Heart Association requirements that have been adopted in the rules and would confer with the Licensing Division. Ditschman also indicated that she can make sure that it is clearly stated in the new rules as to what is acceptable for CPR.

PA 161 Update

Erin Suddeth, RDH, BS, MPA, with MDHHS-Oral Health, reported that they currently have 51 programs including 138 supervising dentists, 268 dental hygienists, and 113 dental assistants.
