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Ditschman announced that Kim Gaedeke has been named Deputy Director of the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs.

Ditschman indicated that in September 2018, Governor Snyder signed an Executive Order, removing the felony questions from employment applications and at the same time directed the Department to stop using criminal convictions, as the basis for an applicant lacking good moral character, in evaluating occupational licenses. Ditschman explained that this is being applied to occupational licensing applications and read the new language that will be used in place of the existing felony question on applications.

Michigan Association of Certified Public Accountants (MICPA)

Peggy Dzierzawski showed a video in the "Great Day" series about being a certified public accountant. She indicated that she has noticed that associations are learning to work with State Boards and thanked the Board for their work.
