Enclosed, please find your next update to the April 2011 edition of the *Michigan Liquor Control Code, Administrative Rules and Related Laws*. The pages included herein replace those already present in your book. You may also wish to visit our website for an up-to-date electronic copy of this publication. The following provides a review of the changes that have occurred since your last update in February, 2012:

- TEMPORARY LIQUOR LICENSE FOR AN OUTDOOR STADIUM USED FOR INTERCOLLEGIATE ATHLETICS EVENTS
 - (HB-5611) P.A. 212 of 2012, Effective June 27, 2012.
 - Amends MCL 436.1531 (Section 531)
 - This law amends the Michigan Liquor Control Code to allow for the issuance of a tavern or Class C license at an outdoor stadium customarily used for intercollegiate athletic events for not more than 30 consecutive days and in conjunction with an outdoor professional hockey game.
- BOTTLE DEPOSIT LAW EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN TYPES OF BIODEGRADABLE CONTAINERS MADE OF ALUMINUM AND PLASTIC OR PAPER
 - (HB-5660) P.A. 213 of 2012, Effective June 27, 2012.
 - Amends 1976 IL 1 (MCL 445.571 - 445.576) by adding sec. 1a.
 - This law amends the Beverage Containers Initiated Law of 1976 to exclude alcohol pouch containers from being subjected to the 10-cent bottle deposit.
- SALES AND SHIPMENTS BY OUTSTATE SELLERS OF BEER
 - R 436.1617
 - Corrected a typographical error in the numbering of the subsections of this rule to correctly reflect subsection (a).


