Felepe Hall appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office and member Brittany McQueer, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Hall and Ms. McQueer offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Olshove made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of Denial dated February 11, 2021 and to remand the matter back to the Licensing Division, as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order. Commissioner Lasher supported and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove and supported by Commissioner Lasher, that the hearings be adjourned at 2:00 p.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
