treatment monitoring, the Respondent's license shall automatically be reinstated. Upon reinstatement the Respondent will be placed on probation two years to comply with the terms of an HPRP monitoring agreement. If license remains suspended for more than six months the Respondent shall petition for reinstatement. After consideration of R. 338.7005 (Rule 5), the Respondent fined \$500.00 to be paid prior to reinstatement.
