Roels stated that the American Dental Association's (ADA) Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE), which is a non-patient based exam, is targeted to be complete in 2020. This exam is also used in Canada. Roels stated that the American Hygiene Association is working to have the patient based portion of the license exam removed.

Weidig reported that she attended the Joint Commission on National Dental Examinations National Dental Examiners' Advisory Forum on June 20, 2018. She stated that it was interesting and a good opportunity.
