Upon reinstatement, Respondent's license is limited for a minimum of two years with no controlled substance prescribing. Respondent must petition for reclassification. Respondent is placed on probation, to run concurrently with the limitation. Terms of probation include compliance with HPRP, quarterly employer reports, and within one year, completion of ten hours of continuing education in the area

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of addiction and substance use disorder. Respondent's license will be suspended if noncompliant with the terms of the limitation and probation.
