Julian Matthew Gordon, PhD – Disciplinary Subcommittee Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

MOTION by Shebroe, seconded by Van Wormer, to accept the Disciplinary Subcommittee Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law. Respondent's license shall be suspended a minimum of 1 day and will be automatically reinstated once a board-approved supervising licensed psychologist is obtained. Respondent is fined \$500.00 to be paid within 60 days. Respondent's license shall be limited for 2 years and must apply for reclassification. Respondent's license is limited to practice under direct, on-site supervision of a fully licensed psychologist pre-approved by the Board. Respondent may practice only in an outpatient psychotherapy setting with no reasonable expectation of contact with patients outside of the clinic. Respondent is limited to no treatment of patients under 18 years of age, as ordered by the Final Order Granting Reinstatement, executed August 4, 2011. Probation shall run concurrent with the limitation. Respondent's supervisor shall provide guarterly reports to the Department advising of Respondent's practice and compliance with the license limitations. If suspension is over 6 months, Respondent shall apply for reinstatement. Respondent shall have 6 months of psychotherapy with a fully licensed psychologist, who is not Respondent's supervisor, and who is pre-approved by the Board Chair, with a final report at the conclusion of treatment.
