A *Notice of Intent to Revoke License* the adult foster care license of Lake Fenton Haus, Family Home was issued on September 23, 2015. A representative of Emmanuel Community Living House signed for and accepted the certified copy of the *Notice* on September 26, 2015.

A written request to appeal this decision was not received within 30 days of receipt of the *Notice*. This letter is to notify you that the license for Emmanuel Community Living House is revoked, effective October 27, 2015.

Please note that the Adult Foster Care Facility Licensing Act requires that a person or corporation deemed to be providing adult foster care must be licensed. Therefore, it is incumbent upon you to properly and timely discharge remaining residents in care. For additional information, please refer to MCL 400.731.

Dear Mrs. Turcas:

Enclosed is a copy of a NOTICE OF INTENT TO REVOKE YOUR LICENSE to operate an adult foster care family home, alleging that you have violated the Adult Foster Care Facility Licensing Act. Your options are as follows:

- 1) You may appeal the Notice of Intent and attend a pre-hearing compliance conference. A Notice of Compliance Conference, which provides the date, time, location, and guidelines of the conference, is enclosed.
- 2) You may appeal the Notice of Intent, waive the compliance conference, and proceed directly to an administrative law hearing.
- 3) You may choose not to appeal the Notice of Intent.

If you choose to appeal the Notice of Intent, the Department must receive your WRITTEN APPEAL within 30 days of your receipt of this Notice. If the Department does not receive your written appeal within 30 days of your receipt of this Notice, you will have WAIVED YOUR RIGHT to an administrative law hearing and the proposed action will be final.

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NOTICE OF INTENT TO  
REVOKE LICENSE

The Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, by Jay Calewarts, Division Director, Adult Foster Care and Camps Licensing Division, Bureau of Community and Health Systems, provides notice of the intent to revoke the license of Licensee, Silvia Turcas to operate an adult foster care family home pursuant to the authority of the Adult Foster Care Facility Licensing Act, 1979 PA 218, as amended, MCL 400.701 et seq., for the following reasons:

1. On or about September 11, 2013, Licensee was issued a license to operate an adult foster care family home, with a current licensed capacity of 6, at 1825 Hiller Road, West Bloomfield, MI 48324.
2. On April 27, 2015, Licensing Consultant Karen LaForest conducted an onsite investigation at 5864 Seville Circle, Orchard Lake, MI 48324 due to allegations that Licensee is providing unlicensed adult foster care at this location. Ms. LaForest spoke with Licensee who admitted that she is providing unlicensed adult foster care to six female residents who were previously residing in

Licensee's licensed facility (license #AF630337505, located at 1825 Hiller Road, West Bloomfield, MI 48324). Licensee explained that the home used for license #AF630337505 was being leased by Licensee and that the owner of the home sold it to another individual in December, 2014. Licensee's lease of the 1825 Hiller Road, West Bloomfield, MI 48324 home expired on March 8, 2015, and from that date she moved the AFC residents into the unlicensed home located at 5864 Seville Circle, Orchard Lake, MI 48324.

3. On May 21, 2015, Licensing Consultant John Pochas conducted an onsite inspection at 1825 Hiller Road, West Bloomfield, MI 48324 and he spoke with Daniela Marit. Ms. Marit stated that Licensee does not live in the home. Mr. Pochas observed that in addition to Licensee not residing in the home there were also no adult foster care residents residing in the home.

#### COUNT I

The conduct of Licensee, as set forth in paragraphs 2 & 3 above, evidences a violation of:

**400.703**

**Definitions; A.**

(5) "Adult foster care family home" means a private residence with the approved capacity to receive 6 or fewer adults to be provided with foster care for 5 or more days a week and for 2 or more consecutive weeks. The adult foster care family home licensee shall be a member of the household, and an occupant of the residence.

COUNT II

The conduct of Licensee, as set forth in paragraphs 2 & 3 above, evidences a violation of:

400.713

**License required; application; form; investigation; on-site evaluation; issuance or renewal of license; disclosures; maximum number of persons; stating type of specialized program; issuance of license to specific person at specific location; transferability of license; sale of facility; notice; items of noncompliance; refusal by department to issue or renew license; conditions; unlicensed facility; violation as misdemeanor; penalty; receipt of completed application; issuance of license within certain time period; inspections; report; "completed application" defined.**

(7) A license shall be issued to a specific person for a facility at a specific location, is nontransferable, and remains the property of the department. The prohibition against transfer of a license to another location does not apply if a licensee's adult foster care facility or home is closed as a result of eminent domain proceedings, if the facility or home, as relocated, otherwise meets the requirements of this act and the rules promulgated under this act.

NOTICE IS GIVEN that Licensee is offered the opportunity to show compliance with all lawful requirements for retention of the license. If Licensee appeals the Notice


of Intent and compliance is not shown, formal proceedings will commence pursuant to the Adult Foster Care Facility Licensing Act, 1979 PA 218, as amended, MCL 400.701 et seq., rules promulgated thereunder, and the Administrative Procedures Act, 1969 PA 306, as amended; MCL 24.201 et seq. Should formal proceedings commence, you have the right to attorney representation at your own expense.

LICENSEE IS NOTIFIED that pursuant to MCL 400.722(3) of the Adult Foster Care Facility Act, Licensee has 30 days from the date of receipt of the Notice of Intent to file a written appeal of the proposed action. The appeal shall be addressed to Joshua Hargrove, Departmental Analyst, Bureau of Community and Health Systems, Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs. Your written appeal must include your name and license number, and must be submitted using one of the following methods:

- Mail your written appeal to the Bureau of Community and Health Systems, P.O. Box 30664, Lansing, MI 48909. It is recommended that you obtain some type of delivery confirmation;
- Fax your written appeal to the Bureau of Community and Health Systems at (517) 284-9709. It is recommended that you keep a copy of your fax confirmation as proof of submittal; or
- Email your written appeal to [DAappeals@Michigan.gov](mailto:DAappeals@Michigan.gov). It is recommended that you keep a copy of the sent email as proof of submittal.

LICENSEE IS FURTHER NOTIFIED that failure to file a written appeal of this action within 30 days will result in revocation of the license.

Pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act, MCL 24.292(1), you are afforded the opportunity to attend an informal compliance conference. The purpose of the compliance conference is to allow you to show that you were in compliance with the Adult Foster Care Facility Licensing Act and the licensing rules promulgated thereunder. You have the right, at your expense, to have an attorney represent you at the compliance conference. You may also bring **one** support person to the compliance conference.

To enable a thorough discussion of the Notice of Intent at the compliance conference, please bring any documents, pictures, etc. that you would like the Department to consider. You may also submit documents to the Department prior to the compliance conference by emailing them to [DAappeals@Michigan.gov](mailto:DAappeals@Michigan.gov).

If you are unable to attend the compliance conference at the scheduled date and time, you may request, in writing, that the Department change the date and/or time. The Department will make all reasonable attempts to accommodate your request, but will not reschedule the compliance conference to a date more than 10 days after the scheduled date. If you promptly notify the Department of your inability to attend the compliance conference as scheduled, the Department may be able to schedule the compliance conference to a date earlier than originally scheduled.

If you are unable to show that you were in compliance with the Adult Foster Care Facility Licensing Act and licensing rules, and a resolution cannot be reached, the Department will forward the matter to the Michigan Administrative Hearing System for the scheduling of a formal administrative hearing. The Michigan Administrative Hearing System will subsequently notify you of the date, time, and location of the administrative hearing.

All Department meetings and hearings are conducted in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act in buildings that accommodate mobility-impaired individuals and have accessible parking. If you require additional accommodations to participate in the compliance conference, please notify the Department at least one week in advance to make the necessary arrangements.

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
