FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

This matter began with a Notice of Intent to Revoke License (hereafter "Notice of Intent") issued on April 15, 2015, by the Child Care Licensing Division of the Bureau of Health Care Services (now in the Bureau of Community and Health Systems), Respondent, concerning the license held by Advance Daycare and Child Development Center, LLC, Petitioner, to operate a child care center under the Child Care Organizations Act, 1973 PA 116, as amended, MCL 722.111 *et seq.* (hereafter "Act"). A properly noticed hearing regarding the matter at issue was held by Administrative Law Judge Eric Feldman (ALJ) on October 15, 2015. Neither an attorney nor authorized representative appeared for Petitioner at the scheduled hearing, and it proceeded in Petitioner's absence under Section 72(1) of the Administrative Procedures Act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 *et seq.* (hereafter "APA"). Respondent requested that a default be entered against Petitioner in accordance with Section 78(2) of the APA. The ALJ granted a default against Petitioner.

On October 16, 2015, the ALJ issued a Proposal for Decision that contained findings of fact and conclusions of law regarding Respondent's Notice of Intent. The parties were notified of the right to file Exceptions to the Proposal for Decision. The record reflects that no Exceptions to the Proposal for Decision were filed by either party within the time set for Exceptions. The Michigan Administrative Hearing System prepared a Certification of Record on November 17, 2015.

The ALJ's Proposal for Decision recommended that the Department Director adopt the findings of fact and conclusions of law, including that Petitioner willfully and substantially

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violated Rules 400.8125(1); 400.8125(3)(b); 400.8140(2)(a); 400.8158(1)(b); 400.8158(3); 400.8182(8); and 400.8167(1)(a) of the Licensing Rules for Child Care Centers, 2013 AACR, R 400.8101 *et seq.* as alleged in the Notice of Intent.

Accordingly, after review of the hearing record and the ALJ's Proposal for Decision, the following Order is entered:

ORDER

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The ALJ's Proposal for Decision issued on October 16, 2015, is hereby adopted in its entirety and incorporated by reference, and made a part of this Final Decision and Order (see attached Proposal for Decision), with the following correction:

The Procedural History on page one (1) of the Proposal for Decision, should state that the Notice of Intent was issued on April 15, 2015, not October 15, 2015; and

2. The action of Respondent to REVOKE Petitioner's license to operate a child care center is hereby AFFIRMED.
