Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:14 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Commissioner Quimby, to approve the Lansing Appeal minutes from October 4, 2011, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Helen Fakhoury, d/b/a Clio Road Drive Thru, 4203 Clio, Flint, Genesee County
Complaint # 0-142991

The violation appeal hearing was conducted for Helen Fakhoury, Complaint # 0-142991. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Kenneth Scott appeared on behalf of the licensee, and Nabeel Fakhoury, husband of licensee, was present. Mr. Geissler and Mr. Scott offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to affirm the decision of Commissioner Colleen A. Pobur, dated March 25, 2011. Supported by Commissioner Quimby, and the motion carried by unanimous vote.

3. Firland Management, LLC, 1160 S Elms, Flint, Clayton Township, Genesee County
Request ID# 580273

The church hearing was conducted for Firland Management, LLC, Request ID# 580273. Jason Geissler appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Hanuman Marur, President of the Kasi Sri Viswanatha Temple appeared for the objecting church, and Attorney Aaron Matthews appeared on behalf of the applicant with general manager Jon Jepson. Mr. Geissler, Mr. Marur, Mr. Matthews and Mr.

Jepson offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion that the findings of the Commission be that the church filed a proper objection under the rules and that the church, having been given the burden of proceeding, has not shown competent material evidence that the establishment would provide any detrimental impact to the safety of the objecting church, and the application should proceed with no impediment. Supported by Commissioner Quimby, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Quimby, supported by Commissioner Weatherspoon, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:16 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
