1. Ellana, Inc., 7459 Joy, Detroit, Wayne County Complaint #1-144550

The violation hearing was conducted for Ellana, Inc., Complaint #1-144550. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Marshal Garmo appeared on behalf of the licensee. Mr. Asevedo and Mr. Garmo offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Weatherspoon made a motion to affirm the Commission Order of Administrative Law Judge Robert H. Mourning, dated October 21, 2011. Commissioner Quimby supported, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

2. Liquor Corner Two, Inc., 1945 Fenton, Flint, Genesee County Request ID#628137

The church hearing was conducted for Liquor Corner Two, Inc., Request ID#628137. Tim Stevens and Shawn Ferrell appeared on behalf of the First Church of Christ, Attorney Peter Abbo and stockholder Amar Shango appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Stevens, Mr. Ferrell, and Mr. Abbo offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Commissioner Quimby made a motion that the church filed a proper objection and the applicant has shown competent material evidence that the establishment would not adversely impact the church.
