Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:05 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Weatherspoon, supported by Chairman Deloney, to approve the Southfield Appeal minutes from October 27, 2011, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. S.B. One, Inc., 48806 Hayes, Macomb, Macomb Township, Macomb County Request ID#614666

The licensing hearing was conducted for S.B. One, Inc., Request ID# 614666. Adam Rubin appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, and Attorney Michael Kiryakoza appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Rubin and Mr. Kiryakoza offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion that the previous Commission Order dated October 12, 2011, be rescinded and the request to transfer ownership of the escrowed 2011 Specially Designated Distributor and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (PM), from Maria Hirmiz, transfer location from 56975 North, Macomb, and new permit to sell alcoholic liquor between 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon on Sundays, be approved. Commissioner Weatherspoon supported, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. Club Armane LTD., 15000-15006 Harper, Detroit, Wayne County Request ID# 608312

The church hearing was conducted for Club Armane, LTD., Request ID# 608312. Adam Rubin appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Keith Echols, Pastor, appeared on behalf of the New Beginnings Cathedral and Clifford Jackson, appeared on behalf of Club Armane, LTD. Mr. Rubin, Pastor Echols, and Mr. Jackson offered

comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion that the church filed a proper objection and the applicant has shown competent material evidence that the establishment would not adversely impact the church. Commissioner Weatherspoon supported, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.
