Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:09 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Lansing Appeal Hearings of December 4, 2012, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. Saugatuck Food Services, Inc., 216 St Peters, Tower Marina, Douglas, Allegan County Request ID# 634609

The show cause hearing was conducted for Saugatuck Food Services, Inc., Request ID# 634609, which was tabled from a hearing on August 14, 2012. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Michael Brown and President R.J. Peterson, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Ms. Hetzel and Mr. Brown offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney advised the findings of the Commission are that the license held by Saugatuck Food Services, Inc., should be cancelled as they are no longer eligible for licensure inasmuch as the licensed premises - the boat - left the state of Michigan, however the Commission finds that the licensee is, in fact, eligible for licensure for either a quota license or for a resort license. Chairman Deloney made a motion that the license be cancelled, as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

3. Family Fare, LLC, 2245 Eighty Fourth, Byron Center, Byron Township, Kent County Request ID# 633104

The licensing hearing was conducted for Family Fare, LLC, Request ID# 633104, which was tabled from a hearing on June 19, 2012. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Manager of Government Affairs, Michael

Gallagher appeared on behalf of the applicant. Also present was Attorney Michael Brown. Ms. Hetzel, Mr. Brown and Mr. Gallagher offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated May 9, 2012, and to approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer location of escrowed 2012 Specially Designated Distributor license only, and new motor vehicle fuel pumps under MCL 436.1541(1), to be held in conjunction with existing 2013 Specially Designated Merchant license with motor vehicle fuel pumps under MCL 436.1541(1). Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. Vik, Inc., 649 NE Clancy, Grand Rapids, Kent County Request ID# 634321

The licensing hearing was conducted for Vik, Inc., Request ID# 634321. Dawn Hetzel appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Michael Brown, sole stockholder Vikramjit Singh, and landlord Naurinder Kaur (mother of stockholder), appeared on behalf of the applicant. Also present was Detective Maureen O'Brien, Grand Rapids Police Department, City of Grand Rapids Commissioner Ruth Kelly and Kristi DeKraker neighborhood association. Ms. Hetzel, Mr. Brown, Mr. Singh, Det. O'Brien, Commissioner Kelly and Ms. DeKraker offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney advised this matter would be tabled for a hearing on a future date, which would give all parties time to meet and discuss the issues with this application and its location.

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 12:02 p.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
