Chairman Deloney called the hearings to order at 10:06 a.m., noting a quorum was present.

1. Moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby, that the minutes of the Southfield Appeal Hearing of March 21, 2013, be approved as written and presented, motion carried by unanimous vote.
2. The hearing for ZMCC, Inc., Request ID# 516769, scheduled for today, has been postponed.
3. Brass Rail LLC, 18-24 W. Adams, Detroit, Wayne County Business ID# 223065

The show cause hearing was conducted for Brass Rail LLC, Business ID# 223065, which was tabled from the Hearing held on September 13, 2012. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Michael D. Langnas, Dominic Yono and Randy Yono, members, appeared on behalf of licensee. Mr. Asevedo and Mr. Langnas offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion that the Commission finds that the licensee has addressed concerns that precipitated the hearing and that no further action will be taken against their licenses at this time, as set forth in the Show Cause Hearing Order. Commissioner Olshove supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

4. City Liquor, Inc., 30444 W. Eight Mile, Farmington Hills, Oakland County Request ID# 673211

The licensing hearing was conducted for City Liquor, Inc., Request ID# 673211. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Kelly Allen and Ronnie K. Kassab, stockholder, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Asevedo and Ms. Allen offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated February 13, 2013 and approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer of all stock interest in 2012 Specially Designated

Distributor and Specially Designated Merchant business with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.) and request for new Sunday Sales Permit (A.M.). Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

5. River Road Management, LLC, 29370 S. River, Harrison Township, Macomb County
Request ID# 480425

The licensing hearing was conducted for River Road Management, LLC, Request ID# 480425. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Frank Palazzolo, and Jimmie Tamburrini, member, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Asevedo, Mr. Palazzolo and Mr. Tamburrini offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated February 1, 2013 and approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer membership interest in 2012 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.) and Outdoor Service (1 Area) by adding Jimmie Tamburrini as new member. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote.

6. Kayla Sky, Inc., 55202-55208 Van Dyke, Shelby Township, Macomb County
Request ID# 671551

The licensing hearing was conducted for Kayla Sky, Inc., Request ID# 671551. Rosendo Asevedo appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Thomas Giachino and Nita Murad, sole stockholder, appeared on behalf of the applicant. Also present was Joey Murad, Husband of Nita Murad. Mr. Asevedo, Mr. Giachino and Ms. Murad offered comments regarding this case. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order of denial dated February 6, 2013 and approve the request as set forth in the Licensing Appeal Order, to transfer ownership of escrowed 2012 Class C license from Carom Club Billiards, Inc. and transfer location (governmental unit) under MCL 436.1531(1) from 35691 Gratiot, Clinton Township, Macomb County. Commissioner Quimby supported, and the motion was carried by unanimous vote

With no further business, moved by Commissioner Olshove, supported by Commissioner Quimby that the Appeal Hearings be adjourned at 11:30 a.m., motion carried by unanimous vote.
