The licensing hearing was conducted for Primetime Steakhouse & Spirits, L.C.C., Request ID# 559274. Susan Moody-Frezza appeared on behalf of the Attorney Generals Office, Attorney Michael J. Brown and Michael Gardynik, sole member, appeared on behalf of the applicant. After discussion on the record, Chairman Deloney made a motion to reverse the previous Commission Order dated March 14, 2012, and approve the request to transfer ownership of the 2011 Class C and Specially Designated Merchant licenses with Sunday Sales Permit (P.M.), Dance-Entertainment Permit, and Specific Purpose Permit (Food) from Butler & Holmes, L.L.C., and cancel existing Specific Purpose Permit (Food). Commissioner Quimby supported, the motion was carried by unanimous vote.
