Application must include statements signed under penalty of perjury by each contractor of record that is the present or former mechanical contractor employer(s) indicating the applicant has a minimum of 3 years or 6,000 hours of performance in EACH work classification for which the applicant is seeking a license and must include a detailed and specific description of the type of work performed by the applicant including the beginning and ending dates he or she performed that work, the length of time the work was performed, the employer under which the work was performed, and the title of the individual signing the statement. The description of work performed must include, but not be limited to, heating/cooling BTU ratings, venting and duct systems, types of fuel, types of refrigerants, types of equipment and types of fire suppression systems and equipment if applicable.

If the applicant provides evidence satisfactory to the department that he or she has successfully completed a 2-year, or equivalent, HVAC program provided by a recognized trade school, community college, or university, or a 2-year HVAC training program approved by the United States Department of Labor, the department shall credit the completion of that program toward the 3 years or 6,000 hours of work experience required. The amount credited, as determined by the department, must not exceed 1 year or 2,000 hours of the 3 years or 6,000 hours required.
