ELIGIBILITY FOR LICENSING

- Complete an internship program developed by the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards (NCARB).
- Complete a National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB) accredited first professional degree in architecture, or meet the NCARB Certification Guidelines, revised July 2016.
- Apply through NCARB until all sections of the Architect Registration Examination (ARE) have been passed. There is a total of 6 divisions of the ARE. For additional information, please visit www.ncarb.org.
- Submit an online application at www.michigan.gov/mylicense.
 - Applicants must be of good moral character. The fee due at the time of the application is \$65.
