

AFC – APPOINTMENT OF DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE

Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs
Adult Foster Care and Home for the Aged Licensing

Pursuant to the adult foster care licensing rules, a resident may appoint a designated representative. "Designated representative" means that person or agency which has been granted written authority, be a resident, to act on behalf of the resident or which is the legal guardian of the resident. Rule 400.14112/400.315102(1)(g).*
